Whereas, there has heretofore been filed in the records of Travis County, Texas, in Plat Book No 1, at page 27, a plat showing Leander Brown's subdivision of the Southeast one quarter of Out Lot 72 Division "D", of the City of Austin, Texas, which plat as recorded shows a street lying between lots 1 to 10, inclusive, in Block 2 of said subdivision on the west, and lots 11 to 20 inclusive in block 1 of said subdivision on the east, which said street is designated on said plat as "Leander Street"; and,

Whereas, by decree of Court in cause No 26031, entitled Tim Byrne et el vs Sidon Harris et al, all the property in said subdivision located onat of said " Leande#

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• Street was located and determined on the ground, which decree had the effect of projectingthe lines of the lots abutting on said Leander street on the east into said street to the extent of making same too narrow to be used for the practical purposes of a street; and,

Whereas, in order to obtain thefull width of said "Leander Street" as platted, it would be necessary to readjust and re-establish all of the property and street lines con-tained in said subdivision situated west of said "Leander Street", which could only be done at great expense and insonvenience both to the City of Austin and to the several owners of the property therein; and,

Whereas, said "Leander Street" has never been actually used by the public as a street, and has never been formally accepted and employed by the City of Austin for such purpose; and,
