Unless physically incapacitated in other ways , we insist that blind persons ought to have the right , and be required, to persue gainful occupations.

While we appreciate Sympathy, we much more appreciate the spirit of independence that every one ought to have, to such a degree that as to impel him or her to make a strenuous effort to earn a living.

We do not believe that the State has done its full duty towards the indepent blind, but also believe that the habit of begging has always stood in the way of having this full duty performed.

Help the blindY s, but by furnishing them something to do, and keep them off the streets as mendicants.
