Rogular moeting of the City Council:

Austin, Toxas, July 3rd 1913.

The Council was called to order by the Mayor: Roll called:
Present Mayor Wooldridge, Councilmen Anthony, Bartholomew, Haynes & Powell 5
Absent none.

. The minutes of the last regular and subsequent recessed meetings were read and approved, be the following vote:

Construencine Aouth autin, V Austin Street Railway Company authority to construct a branch lineor tap from its line of railway beginning at a point on South Congress Avenue opposite the Fredricksburg road; thence running easterly ,across Congress Avenue and over the property of Wallace R Miller; thence Southerly over the property of the Austin Field Club, in all about ten hundred and fifty feet, and also granting to the said Austin Street railway Company the right to take up and remove its tracksand said branch line of railway when it sees fit and proper so to do.

The Mayor laid before the Council the reports of the City Health Officer, tell Helalit Inspector, & the Engineer for the month of June 1913, which were read and ordered filed.

I move a reconsideration of the vote by which the Council adpoted a resolution donating to the African M E Church the church building purchased from that church located on the half block south of Wooldridge Park, for the reason, I do not believe that the Council can legally donate the proorty. If the Council can legally make the donation, I prefer donating what the material will be worth when torn down, which would not be one-fifth of the value of the building.

The half block set anide for Library purposes is 276 feet in length and this building is on the extreme west end occupying about 45 feet leaving 231 feet front on which to erect a Library Building, which is a large front condidering there is a depth of only 128 feet in the half block.

Another reason for retaining this building is the uncertainty of obtaining a Library Building from the Carnagie fundon account of title to the property.

Another is that the people of Austin have not yet voted the funds to maintain a Library.
