

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL:Austin, Texas, March 16, 1940.

The City Council convened in special session at 2:00 P. M., Saturday, March 16, 1940, with all members present.

The following report of the City Manager was received:

WHEREAS, the Augue Packing Company of San Antonio, Texas, has complied with all of the ordinance regulations of the City of Austin and the plant has been inspected by the City Health Officer and designated representatives of the City, and they have recommended to the City Manager that a permit for the sale of meat and meat products be granted; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended to the City Council the authorization of such permit; now, therefore,
