ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 14-2 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO THE PEOPLE'S RENAISSANCE MARKET; REPEALING SECTION 14-2-42 RELATING TO AN APPEAL BY AN APPLICANT OR LICENSEE TO SELL MERCHANDISE AT THE PEOPLE'S RENAISSANCE MARKET AND SECTION 2-1-166 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO THE RENAISSANCE MARKET COMMISSION; AND DISSOLVING THE RENAISSANCE MARKET COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 14-2-12 (*Licensure Authority*) of the City Code is amended to read:

§ 14-2-12 LICENSURE AUTHORITY

The <u>director of the Parks and Recreation Department or his designee</u>
[Renaissance Market Commission] may approve, deny, revoke, or suspend a license issued under this article and may establish procedures related to licensure.

- **PART 2.** Subsection (C) of Section 14-2-19 (*Improvements and Promotional Activities*) of the City Code is repealed.
- **PART 3.** Subsection (A) of Section 14-2-34 (*Application Required*) of the City Code is amended to read:
 - (A) A person seeking a license to sell merchandise in the People's Renaissance Market must:
 - (1) file an application with <u>the</u> director of the Parks and Recreation Department [on a form approved by the Renaissance Market Commission]; and
 - (2) except as provided in Section 14-2-32 (Exemption from License Fee), pay the fee established by ordinance.
- **PART 4.** Subsection (A) of Section 14-2-35 (*Application Requirements*) of the City Code is amended to read:
 - (A) An application under this chapter shall include:
 - (1) the applicant's name, including any business or assumed name, mailing address, phone number, and social security number;

- (2) a state sales tax permit number, if applicable, or exemption certificate;
- (3) a description of the merchandise the applicant intends to sell;
- (4) a statement that the applicant has created or produced all merchandise that the applicant intends to offer for sale at the People's Renaissance Market; and
- (5) a statement that, within seven days of receipt of a request from the director of the Parks and Recreation Department or his designee [Renaissance Market Commission], the applicant agrees to create an example of the applicant's art or craft before the director or his designee [a representative of the commission].
- **PART 5.** Subsections (A) and (C) of Section 14-2-36 (*License Term and Renewal*) of the City Code are amended to read:
 - (A) A license issued under this chapter is valid <u>for one year from the date of issuance</u> [<u>from October 1 to September 30</u>].
 - (C) The director of the Parks and Recreation Department <u>or his designee</u> [or the appropriate advisory board] may automatically renew a person's license if the person has held a license for two consecutive years immediately preceding the renewal application, and has not been found to have violated the terms of the license.
- **PART 6.** Subsection (A) of Section 14-2-39 (*License Issuance*) of the City Code is amended to read:
 - (A) The director of the Parks and Recreation Department shall issue a license approved by the <u>director or his designee</u> [Renaissance Market Commission] under this article.
- **PART 7.** Section 14-2-40 (*Restrictions on Issuance*) of the City Code is amended to read:

§ 14-2-40 RESTRICTIONS ON ISSUANCE

The <u>director of the Parks and Recreation Department</u> [Renaissance Market Commission] shall not approve a license unless the <u>director or his designee</u> [commission] determines that the applicant's art or craft complies with this article.

PART 8. Subsection (A) of Section 14-2-41 (*License Revocation*) of the City Code is amended to read:

ge	The <u>director of the Parks and Recreation Department</u> [Renaissance Market ommission] may revoke or suspend a license issued under this chapter for bod cause, a violation of this chapter, or a public offense or violation by the censee relating to the sale of merchandise at the People's Renaissance Market
PART 9.	Section 14-2-42 (Appeal) of the City Code is repealed.
PART 10. repealed.	Section 2-1-166 (Renaissance Market Commission) of the City Code is
PART 11.	The Renaissance Market Commission is dissolved.
