Purchasing Office RECOMMENDATION FOR COUNCIL ACTION

Subject: Authorize award and execution of a 36-month requirements supply contract with RLS SERVICES, INC., Garland, TX for the purchase of non–captive repair parts for garbage truck bodies for Fleet Services in an estimated amount not to exceed \$1,103,375, with three 12-month extension options in estimated amounts not to exceed \$405,169 for the first extension option, \$425,428 for the second extension option, and \$446,700 for the third extension option, for a total estimated contract amount not to exceed \$2,380,672.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$61,299 is available in the Fiscal Year 2007-2008 Operating Budget of the Financial and Administrative Services Department, Fleet Fund. Funding for the remaining 34 months of the original contract period and extension options is contingent upon available funding in future budgets.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

Purchasing Language: Lowest bid of three bids received.

MBE/WBE: This contract will be awarded in compliance with Chapter 2-9D of the City Code (Minority-Owned and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Procurement Program). No subcontracting opportunities were identified; therefore, no goals were established for this solicitation.

This contract is for the purchase of non-captive repair parts for various manufactured garbage truck bodies for city-owned refuse collection trucks that require after market manufactured repair parts on an as needed basis.

The parts will be used for the daily operations of general routine repair and maintenance services for refuse trucks performed by City mechanics at Service Center No. 11. The City currently has approximately 115 refuse vehicles in the Fleet inventory which include various brands of truck bodies such as Heil, Labrie, Wayne, Leach, Pak-Mor, Smart Truck Systems, and Perkins. This contract is necessary to support the Fleet Service division with a reliable and continuous source of supply to purchase these parts.
