

**ORDINANCE NO.**

**AN ORDINANCE DENYING A CHANGE IN RATES PROPOSED BY ONCOR ELECTRIC DELIVERY COMPANY; REQUIRING REIMBURSEMENT OF MUNICIPAL RATE CASE EXPENSES; AND PROVIDING NOTICE OF THIS ORDINANCE TO ONCOR ELECTRIC DELIVERY COMPANY.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**

**PART 1. FINDINGS:**

- (A) On June 30, 2008, Oncor Electric Delivery Company (“Oncor”) filed a Petition and Statement of Intent with the City seeking to increase rates.
- (B) The City has exclusive original jurisdiction over electric rates within its jurisdiction under the Public Utilities Regulatory Act, specifically Chapters 31 – 38 of the Texas Utilities Code.

**PART 2.** The rate increase proposed by Oncor and filed with the City on June 30, 2008, is denied.

**PART 3.** Pursuant to Texas Utilities Code §33.023, Oncor is directed to reimburse any municipal rate case expenses that the City may incur by participating in a rate case proceeding due to the filing of Oncor’s Statement of Intent, this denial, or any appeal of this denial.
