AN ORDINANCE REZONING AND CHANGING THE ZONING MAP FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 3401 PAISANO TRAIL FROM SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCE STANDARD LOT (SF-2) DISTRICT TO PUBLIC (P) DISTRICT.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The zoning map established by Section 25-2-191 of the City Code is amended to change the base district from single famıly iesidence standard lot (SF-2) district to public $(\mathrm{P})$ district on the property described in Zoning Case No C14-2008-0106, on file at the Neıghborhood Plannıng and Zonıng Department, as follows

A 1898 acre tract of land, more or less, out of the Theodore Bissell League Abstract No. 3, Travis County, the tract of land being more particularly described by metes and bounds in Exhibit "A" incorporated into this ordinance,
locally known as 3401 Passano Trail, in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas, and generally identified in the map attached as Exhibit " $B$ ".

PART 2. This ordınance takes effect on August 4, 2008
