The Austin-San Antonio Intermunicipal Commuter Rail District was created in 2002 by the 77th Legislature with the focus on linking the Austin-San Antonio corridor via passenger rail. The District was initially comprised of four local governments: Austin, Travis County, San Antonio and Bexar County, but since its creation, other cities and counties along the corridor have joined the District. The District works with communities along the corridor to determine the feasibility of commuter rail passenger service within the existing Union-Pacific rail corridor that parallels IH-35 between Georgetown and San Antonio. <u>Member organizations are required to pay annual dues.</u>
