Ordinance ordering an election to be held in all the wards of the
City of Austin Texas, for the purpose of electing a Mayor a City
Marshal, a City Clerk, a City Attorney, a City Treasurer, a City Assessor &
Collector, a City Physician, a City Engineer, and ex-officio, Street Com-
missioner, an Alderman for each of the seven Wards of the City, and
three members of the Board of Trustees of the Public Free Schools, of the
City of Austin Texas, as provided by the Charter of the City of Austin
granted by the Legislature of the State of Texas, and approved March
14th 1899.
