Mayor Cooksey called to order the emergency Special Called Meeting of the Council scheduled for 7:00 p.m. at 8:50 p.m., noting the presence of all Councilmembers. The Mayor announced the purpose of the meeting is to consider two resolutions concerning the Capital Improvements Program.

#### Motion

The Council, on Councilmember Rose's motion, Councilmember Carl-Mitchell's second, adopted a resolution authorizing and approving a construction contract to South Austin Utilities Contractor, Inc. for the construction of Package Plants 5 & 6 at the Williamson Creek Wastewater Treatment Facilities. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM No. 82/23-85. \$3,708,510.00 (7-0 Vote)

### Motion

The Council, on Councilmember Rose's motion, Councilmember Urdy's second, adopted a resolution authorizing and approving a Special Change Order for construction of a 16-inch water line for Jollyville Road, Phase I with Austin Road Company. CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM No. 83/22-04. \$546,743.50. (26% increase of the original contract) (7-0 Vote)
