Third-The ordinance now pending entitled "An ordinance appropriating the sum of \$10,000 for the purpose of paying Approved Accounts" and

Fourth-The report of the special committee appointed to consider the proposition of Mr. D. Simches to compromise a suit against the City, and to act upon same.
