A Special meeting of the City Council is hereby called to meet in the Council Chamber, at the City Hall, on this 27th day of March 1897 at 8 o'clock P.M., for the purpose of ascertaining and declaring the result of the Election held on the 23rd day of March, 1897, for Four Water & Light Commissioners of the City of Austin, to pass an appropriation out of the Earnings Fund, to pay the necessary expenses of the recent election; and to pass an ordinance to pay Approved accounts of the Water & Light Plant.

Council 3 absented to remove returns of election to canvas the vote of the election held March 23rd, 1897, for Four Water & Light Commissioners of the City of Austin, which motion prevailed, and the Mayor appointed W. M. Linn, Belvin, Lawless such committee.
