The following call of the Council was read:

Austin, Texas August 22nd 1898

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Austin, Texas, is hereby called to meet in the Council Chamber at the City Hall, at 8:30 o'clock p.m. this 22nd day of Aug. 1898 for the purpose of considering an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$10,150.<sup>00</sup> for the purpose of purchasing and retiring Water and Light Bonds of the City, also for the purpose of considering an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$6000.<sup>00</sup> for the purpose of purchasing and retiring Funding Bonds of the City.

Ord Appr \$10,150.<sup>00</sup> to purchase & retire to the Bonds Pradd 2<sup>nd</sup> time

The Chair laid before the Council an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$10,150.<sup>00</sup> for the purpose of purchasing and retiring Water and Light Bonds of the City.

The ordinance was read the second time.

Alderman Taylor moved to amend the ordinance by striking out \$10,150.<sup>00</sup> and inserting \$15,250.<sup>00</sup> which motion was lost by the following vote:

Yeas: Aldermen Crooker, Fischer, Maddox, Pradd and Taylor 5.  
Nays: Aldermen Belvin, Haynes, Kuhn, McLenore, Miller, Platt, Powell, Rosengren, Shelley, Stumpff and Zilver 11.

Alderman Taylor moved to suspend the rule and place the ordinance on its third reading and final passage, which motion was lost by the following vote:

Yeas: Aldermen Crooker, Fischer, Maddox, Miller, Platt, Pradd & Taylor 7.  
Nays: Aldermen Belvin, Haynes, Kuhn, McLenore, Powell, Rosengren, Shelley, Stumpff and Zilver 9.

Alderman Townsend entered the Council Chamber.

By Alderman Taylor. An ordinance appropriating the sum of \$6000.<sup>00</sup> for the purpose of purchasing Bonds for the Sinking Fund of Bonds issued prior to May 1st 1890.

The ordinance was passed under suspension of the rules by the following vote:
