place it on its second reading, which Motion was

opening of Grant Chapel on July 21<sup>st</sup> 1901

Alderman Nitschke moved to reconsider the vote by which the  
Council refused to suspend the rule and place the ordinance  
appropriating the sum of \$1125. to pay interest due July 1<sup>st</sup> 1901, on the High  
School bonds, on its second reading - which motion prevailed

It was then moved to suspend the rule and place the ordinance  
on its second reading, which motion prevailed by the following Vote -
