The Mayor and President of the Council being absent, the Council was called to order by the City Clerk and Alderman Nitsche was elected as temporary Chairman

Alderman Schneider moved a call of the Council which was seconded. On motion Aldermen Brooker, Gillis and Maddox were excused. The Marshal was directed to bring in the other absentees

High School bonds

The Chairman laid before the Council an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$1125.⁰⁰ to pay interest due July 1st 1901 on High School bonds. The ordinance was read the second time - Alderman Shumate moved to amend the ordinance by striking out in the caption and body of the ordinance the words figures \$1125 and inserting in lieu thereof the words eight hundred and seven dollars Also strike out in section 1 of the ordinance the figures \$45,000 and insert in lieu thereof \$25,000

The amendments were adopted, and a motion made to suspend the rule and place the ordinance on its third reading and final passage which motion was lost by the following vote, yeas & nays voting
