Report &c.... to whom was referred an Ordinance appropriating the sum of \$500. To pay the fee of J.R. Fisher Esq. in the case of E.L. Bartholomew Receiver vs the City of Austin, in the Supreme Court of the United States, presented a report recommending the passage of the ordinance.

On motion the report was laid over to come up with the ordinance under the head of unfinished business.

S.H. Heaven to return his... Alderman Low, for the claims & accounts Committee to whom was referred the petition of S.H. Heaven for reduction of assessment presented a report stating that under the Charter the Council had no authority to remit taxes hence they recommended that the petition be not granted.

On motion the Committee's report was adopted.

Alderman Low for the claims & accounts Committee to whom was referred the claim of L. A. Jobbing for damages presented a report stating that the claim comes under the jurisdiction of the Water Right Commission and recommended that it be so referred. The report was adopted.

Alderman Crooklen for the Hospital Committee presented a report, submitting a report from the Matron of the Hospital giving a statement of amounts collected from pay patients at the Hospital and of the amounts paid out by her as also the amount paid over to the Assessor & Collector of Taxes. The report was read and on motion was referred to the Finance Committee.

On motion the City Engineer was granted leave of absence from the 24th to the 29th of the present month.

Unfinished business

The Mayor laid before the Council an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$500. for the purpose of paying the fee of J.R. Fisher Esq. for services in the U.S. Supreme Court in the case of E.L. Bartholomew Receiver vs the City of Austin.

The ordinance was read the second time and passed under suspension of the rule by the following vote - Yeas Aldermen Crooklen Davis Low Head & Mortimer Hiltzke Redd Tolnider Shelley Shumate Stumpf Wait - 12 Nays None

Alderman Hume entered the council chamber.

The Mayor laid before the Council the substitute to the spilling ordinance, offered by the ordinance Committee.

On Motion the ordinance with the substitute and the amendment were re-referred to the ordinance Committee with instructions to prepare and submit a new ordinance on the subject.

Section 3. That the City Clerk is hereby instructed to transmit
a copy of this resolution to the President of said Association,
and to request on behalf of the City of Austin that same be
submitted to the convention which will soon convene in the
City of Waco.

Alderman Schneider offered the following resolution

R. & the Austin & North Western Railway Companies
That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of fifty dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary for that purpose

Alderman Schneider moved to strike out the last clause in the resolution, which proposes to appropriate \$100,000. which motion prevailed.

The resolution as amended was then adopted.

By Alderman Maddox An ordinance to permit owners of real estate purchased by the City of Austin at foreclosure date to redeem the same at any time within Ninety days from the taking effect of this ordinance.

The ordinance was passed under suspension of the rules by the following vote
