





ATI sources of revenue, FY 07/08

100% = ~\$1.2 million



Note The University of Texas at Austin does not charge ATI any space utilization fees This represented approximately \$400k of support from UT-Austin to ATI in FY07/08

Impact metrics – economic development (calendar 08 YTD)*

Capital raised

- **\$3 million**, Texas Emerging Technology Fund (State)
- **\$25 million**, private investors

Economic impact to Austin**

- **\$37 million**

Jobs created

- **152 jobs**, direct and indirect/induced
