

RESOLUTION NO.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a funding plan as part of the FY 2007-2008 budget that allocated \$1 million to Holly Neighborhood Programs; and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 of the funds were allocated to the Holly Neighborhood Grants Assistance Program; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

That the City Manager is directed to allocate the following amounts funding a variety of programs through the Holly Neighborhood Grants Assistance Program in the amount of \$103,533 for the following programs:

- Ballet East Dance Company – \$35,000 to continue the Folkloric Dance program at Martin Middle School, extend coordination with the Eaglettes Drill Team program at Martin Middle School, continue funding of current programs at Sanchez and Metz Elementary, and inaugurate a dance/theater program at Metz Recreation Center.
- Metz Recreation Center – \$31,220 to implement an eight month artist-in-residence program at Metz Recreation Center and to fund the “Music on the Hill” outdoor concert series and the “Movies Under the Stars.”
- Camacho Activity Center – \$9,450 to fund the purchase of computer/digital equipment and software for the Center’s Digital Dreams Program

- East Town Lake Citizens Neighborhood Association – \$5,963 to fund a Halloween neighborhood block party
- East Cesar Chavez Neighborhood Planning Team – \$5,700 to fund the development of a Historic District Proposal for the East Cesar Chavez Neighborhood
- Creative Arts Austin – \$5,500 to fund the award-winning youth education and enrichment program “Believe in Me” at Metz Elementary.
- Mexic-Arte – \$5,000 to fund After School Art Classes for children attending Metz, Zavala, and Sanchez Elementary
- Girl Scouts of Central Texas – \$5000 to fund the P.A.V.E. the Way program at Metz Recreation Center.
- East Cesar Chavez Neighborhood Planning Team’s Crime and Safety Committee – \$700 to fund the Annual Halloween Block Party held by the Friendly Fiends from Haskell Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED

That the remaining \$3,533 be allocated from the available funds in the Holly Good Neighbor Program “Cultural Arts” funds.
