Petition of Mrs Mary Connelly asking to have ground feed required - Read and on motion referred to Committee on claims & accounts

Reports of City Officers -

The Mayor laid before the Council the reports of City Officers for the month of August 1902, which were on motion referred to their appropriate Committees without reading

Reports of Standing Committees

Alderman Nitschke for the Street Committee, to whom was referred an ordinance changing the names of certain streets in the City, presented a report recommending that the ordinance do not pass. The report was adopted

Alderman Nitschke for the Street Committee to whom was referred the petition of Mrs S. V. Davis asking the City to purchase a certain strip of ground to be used on street purposes, presented a report recommending that the petition be not granted. The report was adopted

Alderman Nitschke for the Street Committee to whom was referred the petition of Mr W. L. Spike asking the Council to refund him the sum of \$135⁰⁰ amount paid by him for repairs on the sidewalk, presented a report recommending that the petition be granted, with in future since he does not own the sidewalk, that he forthwith return it to the Council and ask for an appropriate payment before doing said work.

Alderman Nitscuke moved that the regular order of business be suspended and that he be allowed to present a petition, which motion prevailed

By Alderman Nitscuke Petition of the Austin Electrical Ry. for permission to change its line of road from to continue down Congress Avenue to first street and the east on first street to its terminus

On motion the petition was granted

Alderman Nitscuke offered the following resolution
 Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin, that the Austin Electrical Railway Company is hereby authorized to remove its track, poles and wires from Congress Avenue along east 2nd street to Trinity Street and south on Trinity Street to first street and in lieu thereof to extend its track down Congress Avenue to first street; thence eastward on first street to a connection with its present tracks thereon and to locate all necessary poles for the purpose of stringing its wires thereon
 Privileges here granted are in connection with and subject to the same terms and conditions as the ordinance heretofore enacted by this Council granting the right to the Austin Rapid Transit Railway Company and its successors and assigns to construct, equip and operate street Railways in the City of Austin, approved the 26th day of August 1891

The resolution was adopted.

New Business

Duty of City Physician paupers

Alderman Shumate, one of the Committee on charity, stated that as a member of that Committee, which has before it for approval bills of certain Physicians for services rendered paupers, he would like to be informed as to the duty of the City Physician in pauper cases. On motion the matter was referred to the City Attorney who was requested to furnish the desired information

On motion Alderman Redd was excused from further attendance at this session of the Council

By Alderman Shelley An ordinance prohibiting the staking of horses, Cows or Whales within the boundaries of the cemeteries of the City of Austin or permitting them to run at large in said cemeteries
