Park Committee : Alderman Nitschke moved that the Park City Atty to investigate Street to Pease Park. And learn if the City has a title to the street leading from West 12th Street to Pease Park, on the east side of Shoal Creek, which motion prevailed.

Paid wagon or ordinance : By Alderman Moore an ordinance appropriating sum of \$200⁰⁰ for the purpose of purchasing a paid wagon and horse etc. The ordinance was read the first time.

Alderman Nitschke moved that it be referred to the Police Committee, with instructions to report on same instant, which motion prevailed.

Report Police Com. : Alderman Shelley for the Police Committee to whom was referred an ordinance appropriating the sum of \$200⁰⁰ for the purpose of purchasing a patrol wagon etc., presented a report recommending the passage of the ordinance, with amendment. On motion the report of the Committee was adopted.

Alderman Crookshank proposed to suspend the rule of place the ordinance on its second reading which motion was lost by the following vote

Special Committee to examine & report on condition of opera houses and buildings to be fire escapes.

Nays Aldermen Haynes Nitschke Tedd Schneider & McH. Alderman Nitschke offered the following resolution. Whereas it is important to the public safety that all opera houses and other places of common resort should be so regulated as to permit of easy escape in case of fire; and, Whereas recent fires in other cities of the country have caused uneasiness in this city as to the safety of such buildings; therefore, Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin, that the Mayor or he and is hereby authorized and requested to appoint a special Committee of three citizens and three Aldermen to examine into, and report on, the condition of all opera houses and other places of public resort in this city.

The resolution was adopted and the Mayor appointed the following as the Committee provided for in same, viz. Aldermen Nitschke Crookshank Moore and Mrs. C. H. Scott J. Attooper Geo. Fiegel

Alderman Moore offered the following resolution which was read and on motion referred to the Street Committee.

No money now : Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin, that hereafter no extra appropriation shall be made for any bridge work, or other structure work, for the City, unless, and until plans and specifications for such work

shall have been drawn by the City Engineer, approved by the Finance Committee, and filed in the office of the City Clerk.

By Alderman Crooker An ordinance appropriating the sum of \$3500.00 for the purpose of repairing the Hall of Protection at cost \$13. The ordinance was read the first time and on motion was referred to the Fire and Finance Committees.
