them, directing them to investigate a certain right of  
way running from Sixth Street to the S & N Railroad.  
The report stated that they had carefully examined  
the abstracts and find that the said City had no  
claim to said road. The report of the Committee  
was adopted.

#### New Business

The Mayor laid before the Council the following resolution  
which was read and adopted

Whereas, John E. Sheltie has made application to the  
Legislature for the laying off a tract of special land to  
extend the limits of the City of Austin on the south  
so as to include within the City limits, certain property  
belonging to him, the said John E. Sheltie

Therefore, be it resolved, that the City Council of  
the City of Austin recommend to the Legislature

the passage of said Law, as the same is satisfactory  
and agreeable to said Council.

Alderman Powell offered the following resolution  
which was read and adopted.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin:  
That West Austin Fire Co #7 be allowed the same  
for food & repairs for the main fire Companies, as  
allowed.

That this resolution be in effect on and after the first  
day of January 1907.

By Alderman Haynes an ordinance to permit owners  
of real estate purchased by the City of Austin at foreclosure  
Sale to redeem the same at any time within six  
months from the taking effect of this ordinance.  
The ordinance was read the first time and passed  
under suspension of the rules by the following Vote:
