B. Regular Agenda

1 Discussion and Action on revisions to the Tree Preservation Ordinance (Michael Embesi)

Update provided on the status of the ordinance. It is currently under staff review. No action was taken.

2 Discussion and action on an ordinance amending sections 25-1-83 and 30-1-114 of the City Code relating to development over a closed municipal solid waste landfill

Approved staff recommendation on forwarding this proposed amendment to the full Planning Commission on July 22, 2008 was approved on Commissioner Sullivan's motion, Commissioner Atkins second <u>on a 6-0 vote</u>.

3 Discussion and possible action on modifications of the multi-family zoning districts to allow a limited amount of land uses otherwise allowed in neighborhood commercial (LR) districts in certain situations (Commissioner Reddy)

No action taken. Commissioner Reddy requested staff to follow up on the status of related efforts. [Note: The issue is being taken up as part of the amendments to the Commercial Design Standards. The current draft amendments would allow a vertical mixed use building on multi-family zoned land if that option were included in an adopted neighborhood plan.]
