WHEREAS, the City wishes to promote and expand the opportunities for the creation of affordable housing in the City of Austin, and

WHEREAS, the Texas legislature enacted Texas Local Government Code Chapter 373A, entitled "Homestead Preservation Districts and Reinvestment Zones", which among other things provides authority to adopt a Homestead Preservation Land Bank Program as a tool to help expand opportunities for the creation of affordable housing, and

WHEREAS, on January 11, 2007, the City Council created a Homestead Preservation District subject to passage of legislation revising certain provisions of Chapter 373A, and

WHEREAS, that legislation was approved, and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to move forward with the preliminary evaluation of creation of a Land Bank Program, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Manager is hereby directed to evaluate the feasibility of establishing a citywide Land Bank Program in order to acquire, hold, and transfer unimproved real property and expand affordable housing opportunities by acquiring additional available properties throughout the City of Austin.
