

ORDINANCE NO. 20081023-047

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING REIMBURSEMENT OF FEES FOR
TEMPORARY VENDING PERMITS FOR THE GREEN CORN PROJECT
AUTUMN CELEBRATION HELD AT THE BOGGY CREEK FARM.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Council finds that the Green Corn Project is a nonprofit corporation, and the Autumn Celebration is open to the public and serves the public purpose of promoting a healthy environment by reducing the use of toxic materials in gardening, and the celebration provides a family friendly civic activity.

PART 2. Council authorizes reimbursement of fees for City of Austin Health & Human Services Department temporary vending permits for the Green Corn Project Autumn Celebration to be held on October 26, 2008 at Boggy Creek Farm in an amount not to exceed \$980.00.

PART 3. This ordinance takes effect on November 3, 2008.


