

Called meeting of the City Council
Austin Texas April 30 1886.
Hon W A Saylor Mayor Presiding

Roll call present Aldermen Schubert, Brueggerhoff, Radkey, Platt and Wilson. On motion of Alderman Platt the council was called and the Marshal sent after the absentees.

Alderman Moore came in and answered to his name. On motion the call of the Council was suspended.

A fine of one dollar was entered against Aldermen Kinney, Metz, Lawrence and Kuppertz for non attendance at this meeting.

An ordinance for the relief of Persons whose real estate had been sold for city taxes and bid in by the City was called up and read second time.

An ordinance repealing Article 57 Section 7 of the revised ordinances of the City of Austin was called up and read second time.

The following Resolution was offered by Alderman Platt which was adopted.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Austin That the City Marshal is hereby authorized to sell for cash to the highest and best bidder the old City Park after giving five days notice of the sale and place of sale which shall be at the south east corner of Block 70 and within legal hours.
