the Mayor to appoint a committee of 5. Aldermen
who in conjunction with the Mayor, may take
such action as they may think necessary to sup-
press lawlessness in the City, and authorizing
said committee to appoint not to exceed 50. special
police, and expenses of such not to exceed \$1000. per night.

The ordinance was read second and third
