for the purpose of considering the general  
appropriation ordinance and the ordinance  
relating to the new fire department building  
and to consider such other matters as may  
then be laid before you.

\$5,146.05

An ordinance appropriating the sum of \$5,146.05  
was called up, on motion of alderman Macae.  
The ordinance was amended to include the  
bill of Eugene Von Brockman for printing the  
minutes amounting to \$74.32 (on motion of alder-  
man Crooker. The caption and the ordinance  
was changed to \$5,220.37 then read third time  
and passed by the following vote, yeas Aldermen  
Schneider, Pillow, Hancock, Wells, Campbell  
Schubert, Underhill, Macae, Warren, Crooker, Wells,  
Cunniff, Holman, Hill, Platt, and Brunner 16.

Ordinance An ordinance entitled "an ordinance authorizing  
of occupation the transfer of occupation licenses," was called up  
license and read on second time, and read on third time  
under suspension of rules, and, upon motion  
passed by a unanimous vote.

 Alderman Crooker called up an ordinance  
 al. for engine titled "an ordinance appropriating fifteen hundred  
 + truck house dollars for the purpose of completing the engine  
 and truck house. The ordinance was read a  
 second time, then read a third time under  
 suspension of the rules, and passed by the  
 following vote, yeas Aldermen Wells, Campbell,  
 Schiber, Underhill, Maas, Warren, Crooker,  
 Odell, Carrington, Coleman, Hall, Brenner - 12.  
 Nays: Aldermen Schneider, Pillow, Hancock,  
 and Plath - 4.

\$175. for A.M.C.  
 Nixon  
 An Ordinance appropriating \$175<sup>00</sup> to pay  
 for services of A. M. C. Nixon for furnishing  
 plans and specification for remodeling the  
 city market house. was introduced and read  
 first time, then laid over.

\$5.00 for S. E.  
 Daniels of  
 Texas  
 An Ordinance appropriating \$5.00 to refund  
 excess taxes paid by S. E. Daniels was introduced  
 by Alderman Odell, and read first time, then  
 laid over.

On motion the council adjourned.
