

The Minutes of a Called Meeting of the City Council  
Austin, Oct. 1, 1887.

Hon. J. W. Robertson, Mayor, presiding

(Roll) (Roll Call). Present Aldermen Brush,  
Cummings, Fisher, Graham, Jones, Platt,  
Phillips, Walker, Warren, Caldwell - 10.

(Call). Absent Aldermen Alexander, Anderson, Caldwell,  
Campbell, Metz, Odell, Schneider, Schubert, Soonsen,  
Northam - 10.

Call of Council. Alderman Walker moved a call of the Council, which  
was duly rec'd. and adopted.

Excused. Alderman Cummings moved to excuse Alderman  
Anderson, Alexander, and Schubert on account of  
illness. Adopted.

Ald. Northam Came in.

Suspend Call. Alderman Phillips moved to suspend the Call. Adopted.  
Alderman Northam moved to adjourn. Lost 5;  
Carried 6.

Alderman Odell Came in.

Alderman Fisher introduced the following: "A resolution  
suspending the sale of lots in Greenwood Cemetery:

"Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of  
Austin, That the City Assessor and Collector be and  
he is hereby instructed not to sell or offer for  
sale any lot or lots in Greenwood Cemetery."

"This resolution shall take effect and be in force  
from and after its passage."

Ald. Came in. Aldermen May, Schneider and Caldwell Came in.

Amendment. Alderman Graham moved to amend the resolution

after the word "Cemetery", by adding "until after the next  
Meeting of the City Council."

Alderman Fisher accepted the amendment.

Alderman Walker moved to adjourn. (is 1 : year, 6; May 2, 9.)  
The resolution was then adopted by the following vote:

Phillips, Alderman - 8.

Nay - Aldermen (Aldwell; Cummings, Edell, Martin, Warren,  
Walters,) Wentworth - 1.
