Austin, Texas, October 11, 1889.

To the Aldermen of the City of Austin:

We, the undersigned aldermen of the city of Austin, hereby call a special meeting of the City Council to meet at the City Hall this the 11th day of October, A. D. 1889, at 8 o'clock p.m., to take such action as the City Council may see proper to take on a pending Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance amending Section two (2) of an Ordinance entitled An Ordinance granting the right of way to the Houston and Texas Central Railway Company; and to repeal an Ordinance entitled an Ordinance amending Articles H 89(1) H 88(2) H 89(3) of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Austin, approved January 12, 1881, approved October 4, 1881.

Alderman Morris moved a call of the Council, which was adopted.

Alderman Linn moved that the Council take a recess of ten minutes. Carried.

Recess having expired, Alderman Morris moved to suspend the call. Adopted.

was read a second time, and on motion the
