Alderman Anderson introduced a resolution inviting the Democratic Executive Committee of the State to call the next State Democratic Convention to meet in this City, and providing for the appointment by the Mayor of a Committee of ten members who shall cooperate with the Committee of Citizens appointed by the Board.
