

RESOLUTION NO.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

WHEREAS, the City Council was requested to review and approve the use of a permanent wastewater easement and temporary working space for the Pickfair Wastewater Lift Station Abandonment Project through dedicated parkland known as Pickfair Park; and

WHEREAS, notice of public meeting to be held on November 20, 2008, was given for three consecutive weeks on October 26, November 2, and 9, 2006 in a newspaper of general circulation; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing was held November 20, 2008, by the City Council to determine the approval of the improvements proposing the use of the parkland; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

The City Council finds that, having taken into account clearly enunciated local preferences, there is no feasible and prudent alternative to the use of the parkland (detailed in the attached Exhibit "A") for a permanent wastewater easement and temporary working space for the Pickfair Wastewater Lift Station Abandonment Project through the dedicated parkland and such proposed use is approved.

The City Council finds that the program of improvements includes all reasonable planning to minimize harm to the parkland from the resulting use.

The City Manager or his designee be authorized to take such measures as may be necessary, favorable or required to secure the lines.
