5 **AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CLASSIFICATIONS AND POSITIONS IN**
6 **THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT;**
7 **ELIMINATING AND CREATING CERTAIN POSITIONS; REPEALING**
8 **ORDINANCE NO. 20080908-008 RELATING TO POLICE DEPARTMENT**
9 **CLASSIFICATIONS AND POSITIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

11 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:**
12

13 **PART 1.** The Council finds:

- 14 (A) The City adopted Texas Local Government Code Chapter 143 (*Municipal*
15 *Civil Service*), which applies to members of the classified service in the Police
16 Department.
- 17 (B) Chapter 143 (*Municipal Civil Service*) provides that the City Council shall
18 establish the classifications for the Police Department and the number of
19 positions in each classification.
- 20 (C) The Police Department recommends the elimination and creation of certain
21 classified positions to improve the delivery of police services and increase
22 efficiency in the Police Department.

23 **PART 2.** The following civil service classifications of the Police Department and the
24 number of positions in each classification are established as follows:

- 25 (A) Assistant Chief 5
26 (B) Commander 22
27 (C) Police Lieutenant 66
28 (D) Police Sergeant 162
29 (E) Police Detective 290
30 (F) Police Corporal 73
31 (G) Police Officer 1003

1 **PART 3.** The number of positions in the classification of Commander in Part 2 of this
2 ordinance is an increase of one from the number in existence immediately before the
3 effective date of this ordinance.

4 **PART 4.** The number of positions in the classification of Police Lieutenant in Part 2 of
5 this ordinance is an increase of two from the number in existence immediately before the
6 effective date of this ordinance.

7 **PART 5.** The number of positions in the classification of Police Sergeant in Part 2 of
8 this ordinance is an increase of eleven from the number in existence immediately before
9 the effective date of this ordinance.

10 **PART 6.** The number of positions in the classification of Police Detective in Part 2 of
11 this ordinance is an increase of two from the number in existence immediately before the
12 effective date of this ordinance.

13 **PART 7.** The number of positions in the classification of Police Corporal in Part 2 of
14 this ordinance is an increase of one from the number in existence immediately before the
15 effective date of this ordinance.

16 **PART 8.** The number of positions in the Classification of Police Officer in Part 2 of this
17 ordinance is an increase of sixty six from the number in existence immediately before the
18 effective date of this ordinance.

19 **PART 9.** The Base Salary Schedules attached to the Meet and Confer Agreement
20 ratified on September 25, 2008, are adopted for each civil service classification except
21 Assistant Chief.

22 **PART 10.** Ordinance No. 20080908-008 is repealed.

23 **PART 11.** The Council finds that the need to timely increase authorized staffing in the
24 classified service of the Police Department constitutes an emergency. Because of this
25 emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate
26 preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
