Subject: Approve an ordinance amending Section 12-4-64 of the City Code by adding Concordia University Drive from R.M. 620 to Concordia University (Main Entrance) to the list of streets having a maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour at all times.

Amount and Source of Funding: Funding in the amount of \$220 is available in the approved Fiscal Year 2007-2008 Operating Budget of the Public Works Department for the installation of necessary signs.

Fiscal Note: There is no unanticipated fiscal impact. A fiscal note is not required.

In order to modify or alter the existing prima facie speed limit of a street, the Texas Traffic Laws require that a traffic engineering investigation be performed. An investigation was conducted by the Public Works Department in accordance with the procedures specified in the Texas Procedures for Establishing Speed Zones, November 2006. As a result of this investigation, the Transportation Division recommends the following:

Amendment to Code Section 12-4-64 (35 MPH Traffic Zone)
