ORDINANCE NO. <u>20081218-072</u>

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE AUSTIN POLICE DEPARTMENT NORTHEAST SUBSTATION, LOCATED AT 906 EAST ST. JOHN AVENUE, AS THE CAPTAIN LOUIE WHITE NORTHEAST SUBSTATION; AND WAIVING APPLICABLE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 14-8 OF THE CITY CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. The Council finds that:

- (A) Captain Louie White served the Austin Police Department and the City of Austin honorably and with distinction for nearly three decades.
- (B) Louie White challenged and overcame racial barriers to become the first African American Captain of the Austin Police Department.
- (C) Captain White exhibited acts of valor earning him numerous awards, including the Austin Police Department Medal of Honor and the Life Saving Award.
- (D) Captain White demonstrated humanity, professionalism and tenacity throughout his career and served as a mentor and role model for young officers.

PART 2. The Northeast Subdivision of the Austin Police Department, located at 906 East St. John Avenue, is named the "Captain Louie White Northeast Substation" in honor of Captain White's long and distinguished career as an Austin police officer and his demonstrated commitment to public service.

PART 3. The council waives facility naming requirements of Chapter 14-8 of the City Code related to the naming of the Northeast Substation.

PART 4. This ordinance takes effect on December 29, 2008.
