Brennan of Paris, Texas, to build the superstructure of the power house for the sum of \$45,650, and that a motion prevailed requesting your honorable body to authorize the contract with Mr. Brennan to be executed.

to the H. Wayne Electric Company — I have the honor to inform you that the Board contracts for City of Public Works, at a meeting held on this date, accepted General Electric Company's proposal for furnishing the City with an electric plant as follows:

The General Electric Company to furnish four multipolar generators for converting 500 horse power into electric power with power 6000 connections, at station, for \$15,000.00

The York Wayne Electric Company to furnish four 2500 16 candle power light alternating current incandescent dynamos wound for 1000 volts, and four 1600-

16-candle power light alternating current incandescent dynamos wound for 2000 volts, making a total capacity of 16,400 lights, with all switch boards connections and necessary apparatus inside the Station, for \$7.950.00

A motion prevailed by the unanimous vote of the Board requesting the City Council to authorize the Mayor to close the contracts for said plant with such companies in accordance with their respective proposals.
