

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of the City Council.
Austin Tex. Nov. 21, 1887.

Hon. J. W. Robertson, Mayor, presiding.

Roll Call Roll Call! Present, Aldermen Alexander, Caldwell, Campbell, Cummings, Fisher, Phillips, Schuber, Townsend, Walker, Warren and Wortham - 11.
Absent: Aldermen Anderson, Brush, Graham, Jones, Metz, Odell, Platt, Schneider, Wellmer - 9.
Call of Alderman Walker moved a call of the Council, which was duly seconded and adopted.

Ald. Odell. Alderman Odell was excused, on account of sickness.

Ald. Brush. Alderman Brush entered.

Call Suspended. In motion, the Call was suspended.

Minutes. The minutes of the last meeting of the Council were adopted as printed.

Stone Crossings. In Compliance with a resolution adopted at the last meeting of the Council, the City engineer presented a plan and estimate of Cost of Stone Crossings on Congress Avenue from Pine Street to Mulberry street, inclusive, and on Ocean Street from Guadalupe Street to Red River Street, inclusive. The report distributes the Cost as follows: Eleven Crossings on Congress Avenue, at \$50 each, \$550; Eighteen Crossings on Ocean Street, at \$37.50 each, \$675. Total, \$1225.

The report was read and laid over.

Ald. Schneider & Metz. Aldermen Schneider and Metz came in.

Election. Alderman Phillips introduced a resolution, which was adopted, providing for a general election for the purpose of electing a Mayor in place of J. W. Robertson, whose term expires, and also one alderman from each of the wards in the city, in place of those whose terms expire, as follows:

Provision is also made for the election of three trustees of the public Schools of the city in place of Walter Tipton, Jm Litten and Rm. Swearingen, whose terms expire. A fine which was assessed in the Recorder's Court against D. Isabel, was at the request of the mayor remitted.

Rock Crossings

Alderman Platt entered.

Alderman Fisher introduced an Ordinance appropriating the sum of \$1225, for the purpose of laying Rock Crossings on Congress Avenue and Kean Street. It was referred to the Committee on Streets, bridges, etc.
