Mayor L. M. Crooker, presiding.
 Roll called. Present - Aldermen Melz
 Platt, Robertson, Reichman, Sheehan
 and Tobin. Absent - Aldermen
 Boardman, Duff, Nalle and Gohsenbryer.
 Quorum present.

Minutes of regular meeting, December
 6th 1880 read and approved.

The Mayor stated that he had
 called the council together for the
 purpose of canvassing the returns of
 election held for city marshal on
 Friday, December 14th 1880.

Aldermen Platt Reichman and
 Melz were appointed tellers, the vote
 being counted, the following was
 declared the result: Ben Thompson
 849, John Kelly 621, John Farrell 11
 John Pickle 130, R. Bruce 23. Mr Thompson
 having received the highest vote was
 declared elected city marshal of the
 city of Austin.

Approved Jan 3rd 1881
