

Called Meeting of City Council
Austin Texas. Sept 7th 1880

Mayor L. M. Crocker presiding

Roll Call. Present, Aldermen Boardman, Mills.
Nale. Platt, Robertson and Sherman
Absent, Aldermen Beckman, Fisher, and Wahnemacher.

Program Present.

The Mayor stated that he had called the Council together to appoint places and judges of Election for six Precincts, to be voted for on August 20th 1880.

The same being read by to the Council by the Mayor they were agreed upon by the Council as recited in the Mayor's proclamation.

Petition of L. M. Bell to continue his variety show on East Pecan Street was read and the vote being 3 yeas and 3 nays, the Mayor voted in the negative.

Alderman Nale moved a call of the Council, which being duly seconded, the Marshal was dispatched for the absent Aldermen.

On Motion, Alderman Nale was excused from fines for being absent from Council Meetings for reason of his absence from the City.

Alderman Robertson moved that the call be suspended. Carried.

On Motion the Council adjourned.
