

Called Meeting of City Council.  
Austin Texas, June 21<sup>st</sup> 1878.

Mayor De Gress. Presiding. Roll Called.  
Present Aldermen Crow, Millet, Crow, Sherman,  
Strong and Vaughan. 6.

Alderman Strong moved a call of the Council.  
The call being sustained by three, the City  
Marshal was sent for the absentees.

The proceedings of the meeting of June 12<sup>th</sup> were  
read and approved.

Aldermen Metz and Platt appeared and  
answered to their names. On motion of  
Alderman Crow, Aldermen Crooker and Kalle  
were excused from attendance at this meeting. On  
motion of Alderman Millet the call was  
suspended.

Report of Special Committee on printing and  
binding the Codified Ordinances.

On motion the report was laid over to next  
regular meeting.

By Alderman Millet.

An Ordinance appropriating \$250.<sup>00</sup> to build  
a foot bridge over Waller Creek on Red River  
Street.

Ordinance read first time and motion to sus-  
pend the rules lost two thirds of a full Coun-  
cil not voting in the affirmative.

Petitions of Henry Daniels and J. H. Link to  
establish butcher stalls. Granted.

By Alderman Vaughan a resolution to author-  
ize the Mayor to advertise for bids for the  
repairing of the bridge over the branch east  
of Shoal Creek in the 5<sup>th</sup> Ward. Adopted.

Petition of T. J. Harritt to run a water  
lead from his waste pipes to the gutters  
of Congress Avenue. Granted.

By Ald. Crow. An Ordinance defining certain articles  
of the City Ordinances.

Read first time and on motion of Alderman  
Strong referred to Ordinance Committee.

By Alderman Crow. Resolved that hereafter  
only a short synopsis of the proceedings of  
the City Council shall be printed in the

official paper of the city.

Resolved further that all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Resolution adopted.

By Alderman Strong.

Resolution authorizing the Mayor to advertise for bids for repairing Leeburn Street bridge over Maller Creek. Adopted.

Petition of F. L. Britton for fees as city atty alleged by him to be due.

Alderman Millett offered the following resolution which was adopted.

Resolved. That the claim of Mr. F. L. Britton be laid on the table.

The petition was therefore laid on the table.

An Ordinance fixing the compensation of Aldermen of the City of Austin.

Read third time and on motion passed by the following vote: Yeas, Aldermen Metz, Platt, Parish, Shubert, Strong & Vaughan 6.  
Nays Aldermen Brown & Millett 2.  
Absent Aldermen Crocker & Hall 2.

On motion the Council adjourned.
