

Called Meeting City Council
February 9th 1878

Council called to order at 12 No
Mayor DeSousa in the Chair

Roll called and the following Members an-
swered. Aldermen Brown, Crocker, Millett Miller
Mortley, Metz, Halle, Platt and Strong

Absent Alderman Sheehan, Quorum present

The Mayor states to Council that he had
called them together for the purpose of laying before
them, certain Ordinances, making appropriations
for the location of the building of the grand temple
of the Right Worthy Grand Lodge of the Independent
Order of Odd Fellows, for their consideration and
action

Alderman Mortley introduced the following
Ordinance

An Ordinance leasing a public square
in the City of Austin, now unoccupied to the
R. W. G. Lodge of I. O. O. F. of the State of Texas

The Ordinance was read

Alderman Brown moved to suspend the rules
and put the Ordinance on its second reading

The Yeas and Nays ordered and the motion
to suspend the rules carried by the following vote

The Ordinance was read the second
time

Alderman Miller moved to further suspend
the rules and put the Ordinance on its third
reading

Metz, Martley Halle, Platt and Strong, Nays none

Alderman Miller moved that a Committee
of two be appointed to inform the Grand Lodge
of the action of the Council

Aldermen Martley and Strong were ap=
pointed on the Committee

On motion the Council adjourned
