Called Meeting of City Council  
September 6<sup>th</sup> 1874

Council called to order at 12.15 P.M.  
M. A. Taylor President of the Board of Aldermen in  
the Chair.

Roll called and the following members answered  
Aldermen. Cook, Deffenbaugh and Withers

Absent. Aldermen Brunoid, James, Larmon,  
Maas, Robinson and Ward.

Alderman Cook moved a call of the  
Council. Call sustained and the Marshal was  
directed to bring in the absentees.

Aldermen Brunoid and Robinson came  
in and answered. Quorum present.

The President stated to Council that he had  
called them together for the purpose of laying before  
them the official of the Mayor of Paris Texas for as-  
sistance. That city having recently been mostly destroyed by  
fire and its citizens are in a destitute condition.

Alderman Robinson moved that Council Adjourn  
to 8 o'clock this P.M. on account of there not being a  
sufficient number of members present to pass an ordinance  
making the necessary appropriation. Carried.

At the adjourned meeting there were but three  
members in business transacted and they left the Coun-  
cil chamber at 9.15 with the understanding to meet at  
12 M. Sept 7<sup>th</sup>.
