

Called Meeting of City Council
April 26 1877

Council called to order at 3.45 P. M.
Mayor Wheeler in the chair

Roll called and the following members answered
Aldermen Bremond Cook. Doffenbaugh. James. Lorman
Robinson and Rusk

Absent Alderman Taylor. Quorum present
The Mayor informed the Council that he had called them
together for the purpose of laying before them a petition from
J. D. Boudreau who was desirous of leasing the old mill
property for manufacturing purposes. Also to open the returns
of the judges of the Election held in ward 11-10 on the 20th ult
for Alderman in said Ward.

Louis Moas Alderman elect from ward #10
being present, the Mayor administered to him the Oath of
Office and he qualified and took his seat

Petition of J. D. Boudreau for lease of old
mill property was read

Alderman Cook moved that the petition
be granted

Alderman Bremond moved to amend
the motion of Alderman Cook by referring the petition
to a committee of two in connection with the Mayor with
power to act The Amendment was accepted

Alderman Taylor came in and took his seat and
was recorded present

The petition was read for the information of

Alderman Taylor

The Yeas and Nays ordered and the motion as amended carried by the following vote

Yeas Alderman Bremond, Cook, Duffenbaugh, James, Larmour, Robinson, Root Taylor and Mayo
Nays none

The Mayor appointed Aldermen Robinson and Cook on the Committee

On Motion of Alderman Bremond Alderman Taylor was added to the Committee

Petition of Lusk and to be relieved from payment of License as Butcher from to

On Motion of Alderman Bremond the petition was referred to the Mayor and Board of Health Committee with power to act (passed unanimously Yeas & Nays equal)

Alderman Bremond moved that Council should be engaged to attend to the interests of the City in certain cases now pending in the District Courts where the City of Austin is a party
Carried

Petition of N. B. Reel for reduction in Tax of a farm on certain property for the year 1876

Alderman Bremond moved that the petition be referred to a Committee consisting of the Mayor, Alderman Duffenbaugh and James with power to act
Carried

The Mayor appointed Alderman Mayo on the Finance, Police and Sanitary Committee

On Motion of Alderman Cook the Council adjourned
