Special meeting of the City Council.

Present: Alderman S. Musser, President of the Board

Aldermen: Brigggerhoff, Brommer, Ruess, Eggleston & Robinson

An motion of Alderman Musser, Ord. No. 244, be amended to read as follows: "No building or addition to a building, the outer walls of which are in whole or partly constructed of wood, shall be erected upon any lot or real estate fronting upon Congress Avenue, or Pinar street, from Sabini str. to Congress Avenue, and upon Pine street from Sabini street to Congress Avenue, as the same is laid out on the plot of the city."

Alderman Eggleston moved to amend by striking out the words "upon Pine street from Sabini street to Congress Avenue," and to make the above read "upon Pine street from the Passenger Depot to Congress Avenue", which was lost; after which the original motion was adopted and the ordinance passed to take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

On motion, the meeting adjourned.
