Monday August 1st. 1870  
City Council met pursuant to adjournment

His Honor Leander Brown Mayor in the Chair  
Roll called and the following named Alderman  
answered to their names. Alderman Bennett  
Baker, Palmer, Parson and Rosselke

Minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> July were read  
and adopted.

Reports for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarters of the fiscal  
year, was presented by His Honor the Mayor the Asses-  
or and Collector and by the Treasurer were presented  
and read.

The Reports show that there is \$11,700 specie  
balanced in the hands of the Mayor and \$544.50 in  
the hands of the City Treasurer.

The Assessor and Collector's report shows \$212.50  
Currency to be due to him. On motion those reports  
were referred to the Finance Committee.

Report by the City Sexton for the month of  
July was presented and read. Showing 15 deaths of  
adults and Eight Children

Alderman Parson moved that

"Be it Ordained that in Article 168 Section 1.  
and line 6 the word ten be stricken out and the  
word one be substituted" which on Motion, was  
read, Rules suspended and the Ordinance passed  
its 2<sup>d</sup> and 3<sup>r</sup> reading, and passed by a unanimous  
vote

Alderman Baker introduced the following  
Resolution.

Resolved that after the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
August 1870, the salary of the City Marshal,  
shall be Fifty dollars per Month with fees of Office;  
which resolution being read was ~~on motion~~  
<sup>on motion</sup> Seconded and the roll being called was adopted by  
the following vote: Alderman Bennett, Baker,  
Palmer, Parson, and Rosselke voting Aye —

Alderman Baker introduced the following  
Resolution

Resolved that the Mayor be authorized  
to issue Ten percent City Warrants in sums of

One hundred dollars, to the amount three thousand two hundred and Sixty-two dollars and Sixty Cents, or as much thereof as may be necessary to complete the payment on the Market house, according to the Contracts made with A. H. Cook and Sonnes and Christian; said warrants to be due and payable six months from date.
