

ORDINANCE NO. 20090115-052

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12-4-64(D) OF THE CITY CODE TO ADD A PORTION OF CASSADY DRIVE TO THE LIST OF STREETS HAVING A MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT OF 20 MILES PER HOUR DURING CERTAIN TIMES IN A SCHOOL ZONE FOR SUMMIT ELEMENTARY SCHOOL; AND PROVIDE FOR EMERGENCY PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

PART 1. Section 12-4-64(D) (*Table of Speed Limits*) is amended to add the following street section to the list of streets with a maximum speed of 20 miles per hour during certain times in a school zone:

Cassady Drive from 80 feet east of Cabana Lane to 670 feet east of Cabana Lane
(Summit Elementary School).

PART 2. The amendments made in this ordinance shall be incorporated in alphabetical order and the existing subsections renumbered accordingly.

PART 3. Council finds that school is in session, and the need for a school zone at this site constitutes an emergency. Because of this emergency, this ordinance takes effect immediately on its passage for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety.
