VARIANCE REQUESTED: The applicant has requested a variance from the maximum fence height requirement of Section 25-2-899 (D) from 6 feet to 13 ½ feet at the highest point (along the rear property line) in order to maintain a fence for a single-family residence in an "SF-3-NP", Family Residence – Neighborhood Plan zoning district. The Land Development Code states that a solid fence constructed along a property line may not exceed an average height of six feet or a maximum height of seven feet.

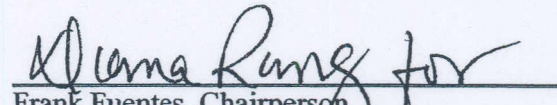
BOARD'S DECISION: TO GRANT BUT DUE TO NOT ENOUGH VOTES, CASE IS DENIED 4-3
