AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION 25-10-153 RELATING TO REQUIREMENTS FOR SIDEWALK SIGNS.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

**PART 1.** Subsection (B) of City Code Section 25-2-153 (*Sidewalk Signs*) is amended to read:

## § 25-10-153 SIDEWALK SIGNS.

- (A) A sidewalk sign is permitted <u>in accordance with the requirements of this section</u> [in the downtown sign district or on property in the university neighborhood overlay (UNO) zoning district].
- (B) The building official shall issue a sign installation permit for a sidewalk sign if the sign complies with <u>the following requirements:</u> [this section.]
  - (1) The sign must be located:
    - (a) on a sidewalk at least 10 feet in width;
    - (b) directly in front of a building that is not set back from street right-of-way, if the sign is located in the street right-of-way;
    - (c)[(b)] for a unified development, on a sidewalk directly in front of the applicant's business;
    - (d) no closer than 20 feet from a driveway or pedestrian crosswalk; and
    - (e) in coordination with other permitted right-of-way uses, as determined by the building official.
  - (2) The sign must not:
    - (a) narrow the sidewalk to less than 10 feet in width;
    - (b) obstruct the line of sight for oncoming traffic;
    - (c) be more than four feet high; or
    - (d) be wider than the lesser of one-third the width of the sidewalk, or 30 inches.

(C) An applicant must provide the	building official with proof of:
installation, use, or ma	protecting the City from liability arising from intenance of the sign, in accordance with the 25-10-235 ( <i>Insurance</i> ); and
(2)[(b)] indemnification o installation, use or main	f the City for liability arising from the tenance of the sign.

(E)[(4)] A business may not use mo	ore than one sidewalk sign.
[(5) A sidewalk sign may no	ot be:
(a) more than four fe	et high; or
(b) wider than the le 30 inches.]	esser of one third the width of the sidewalk, or
(F)[(C)] Notwithstanding any other	er provision of this Code to the contrary:
(1) a sidewalk sign may of street right-of-way; and	contain or use a supporting device placed on
