Subject: Conduct a public hearing for the full purpose annexation of Barclay Drive ROW Annexation Area (Approximately 0.10 acre in Travis County at the northernmost extent of Barclay Drive which is approximately 400 feet north of the intersection of Barclay Drive and Wild Briar Pass).

Prior Council Action: February 12, 2009 - The City Council set public hearings for February 26, 2009 and March 5, 2009.

The Barclay Drive ROW Annexation Area (approximately 0.10 acre) is located in Travis County at the northernmost extent of Barclay Drive which is approximately 400 feet north of the intersection of Barclay Drive and Wild Briar Pass. This area is currently in the city's limited purpose jurisdiction and includes a small portion of right-of-way that has been entirely surrounded by previous annexations, the most recent occurring in December 2008. This area is adjacent to the city's full purpose jurisdiction on four sides and annexation of this area will help ensure appropriate emergency dispatch and increase efficiency in the delivery of public safety services to this area.
