DEPARTMENT COMMENTS:

Further research by staff into the history of the house and its occupants revealed that John Henry Faulk, for whom the house was originally going to be named, only lived in the house for a short period of time and purchased another house down the street; later residents of the house included Ted and Kay Powers, both of whom have historic significance: Ted Powers was a world-known photographer, and Kay Powers wrote a popular column for the Austin American-Statesman for many years. The name of this house should therefore reflect both its association with John Henry Faulk, as this was the house he purchased upon his return to Austin after being blacklisted for his alleged Communist associations in New York City, as well as Ted and Kay Powers.
